Please notes cheques made payable to "Royston in Blue" must be received no later than **Friday 7th June 2019**.

Please ensure that if your child is under 18 there should be a responsible adult with them. The adult does not have to enter the fun run/walk. The aerobic warm up starts at 10.40am and the race starts promptly at 11am.

By signing and returning this entry form you declare that you are aged 18 or over and to the best of your knowledge fit to take part in the event and that you have no medical conditions that would endanger you or others taking part. If in doubt you should consult your own GP. This is a multi-terrain event, you understand and accept that you will run/walk entirely at your own risk and that the organisers accept no liability for death, accident, injury, loss or damage to you or other participants that may arise before, during or after the event as a consequence of an entrant's participation in the event. If an injury does occur please notify one of the event organisers or marshals immediately.
