The run will take place at: Therfield Heath, Baldock Road, Royston, Herts, SG8 5BG

<u>Registration</u>: You can download your entry through the Royston in Blue website <u>www.roystoninblue.co.uk</u> or Racebest website <u>www.racebest.com/races/844sk</u>. We encourage you to enter before the day due to limited spaces.

We encourage runners to set up a Just Giving page enabling you to collect sponsorship online. Simply select Teenage Cancer Trust as your chosen charity and mention on the page that you are participating in Royston In Blue. T-shirt collection dates will be advised through our Facebook, Twitter and Instagram pages nearer the time. If you are unable to collect on these dates, please allow enough time on race day. Due to race license regulations no one will be allowed to take part in the fun run/walk if they are not wearing a 2024 Royston in Blue T-shirt and race number.

Entry includes an exclusive t-shirt; **Children's size**, age 3-5, 7-10 and 11-13 **Adult sizes** S, M, L, XL and XXL Please be aware we cannot guarantee availability of all sizes and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. At the end of the run/walk you will be presented with a medal.

Please ensure that if your child is under 16 there should be a responsible adult with them. The adult does not have to enter the fun run/walk. The aerobic warm up starts at 10.40am and the race starts promptly at 11am.

By signing and returning this entry form you declare that you are aged 16 or over and to the best of your knowledge fit to take part in the event and that you have no medical conditions that would endanger you or others taking part. If in doubt you should consult your own GP. This is a multi-terrain event, you understand and accept that you will run/walk entirely at your own risk and that the organisers accept no liability for death, accident, injury, loss or damage to you or other participants that may arise before, during or after the event as a consequence of an entrant's participation in the event. If an injury does occur, please notify one of the event organisers or marshals immediately. We do not provide any personal insurance but if you wish to take out such a policy then the organisers recommend that you seek professional advice. The organisers do not accept any liability for loss, theft, or damage to any property whatsoever. If any terms herein are unenforceable, they will be severable, and the remaining terms will be enforceable. The following agreement has been put together to help you fundraise within the guidelines of the Charity Commission. The volunteers and fundraisers are always asked to uphold the reputation of the charity.
