Registration: You can Register via the RaceBest website [Royston In Blue 2026 - RaceBest](#) or use the Royston in Blue QR code which will take you to the RaceBest registration. **YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ENTER ON THE DAY.**

We encourage runners to set up a JustGiving page enabling you to collect sponsorship online. Simply select Teenage Cancer Trust as your chosen charity and mention on the page that you are participating in Royston In Blue.

T-shirt collection dates and times will be advised through our Facebook, X and Instagram pages two weeks prior to the event. If you are unable to collect on these dates, you may collect on race day, but please do allow plenty of time. For insurance purposes, no one will be allowed to take part in the event if they are not registered and wearing a race number.

Entry includes an exclusive t-shirt; **Children's sizes**, age 3-4, 7-8, 9-10 and 11-12 **Adult sizes** S, M, L, XL and XXL. T-shirt size preference is required at registration. We will endeavour to provide everyone taking part with their desired size; however we cannot guarantee the availability of all sizes, and they will be allocated on a first come first served basis. At the end of the run/walk you will be presented with a medal.

Please ensure that if your child is under 16, they must have a responsible adult with them. The adult does not have to enter the fun run/walk.

The aerobic warm up starts at 10.40am and the race starts promptly at 11am.

By agreeing to our terms and conditions when you register via RaceBest you are declaring that you are aged 16 or over and to the best of your knowledge fit to take part in the event and that you have no medical conditions that would endanger you or others taking part. If in doubt you should consult your own GP. This is a multi-terrain event, you understand and accept that you will run/walk entirely at your own risk and that the organisers accept no liability for death, accident, injury, loss or damage to you or other participants that may arise before, during or after the event as a consequence of an entrant's participation in the event. If an injury does occur, please notify one of the event organisers or marshals immediately. We do not provide any personal insurance but if you wish to take out such a policy then the organisers recommend that you seek professional advice. The organisers do not accept any liability for loss, theft, or damage to any property whatsoever. If any terms herein are unenforceable, they will be severable, and the remaining terms will be enforceable.
